## **Reasons for Child Separation in Treatment**

- Relationship building with your child Having your child one-on-one with the Doctor and/or Dental Hygienist/Assistant gives us the opportunity to build a trusting and caring relationship.
- Cooperation and behavior advantages Your child will have better cooperation and acceptance towards treatment if your child's attention is directed at the Doctors and/or Dental Hygienist/Assistants instructions versus attention directed towards the parent.
- Sterilization of the treatment area We strive to maintain the cleanest (sterile) treatment environment for your child. Having more people (parents) in the treatment area would invite a higher risk of infectious diseases and uncleanliness to our patients and staff.
- Health information confidentiality (HIPAA) We are required by law to maintain our
  patients confidentiality in terms of their health and dental history. With many parents in
  the treatment area, this confidentiality is compromised.
- Safety regulations (OSHA) We are required by law to maintain a safe working environment for our staff. This includes requiring any person in the treatment area directly related to dental treatment to wear safety items (ie. Gloves, masks, eye protection).
- \* If our office needs the assistance of you as a parent to assist in treating your child, we will get you from the waiting area and seek your assistance.
